

Minutes of the Dallesport/Murdock Community Council December 20, 2010

Special meeting was called to discuss the SEPA 2010-50 and SEPA 2010-51.
Klickitat County Determination of Non-significance.

After some delay due to not having a quorum present, the meeting was called to order at 7:40 pm.
Council member present were Don McDermott, Jack Kincheloe, Elaine Kincheloe Jack Cherry, Art Mengert, Dennis Hoeye, and Renee Briggs.

The meeting was to decide weather or not the Dallesport Community Council would file an appeal to these proposals. Sepa 2010-50 would allow second accessory dwellings on lots that currently only allow one per lot. Sepa 2010-51 proposed to update the Dallesport Murdork Sub-Area Plan which is a component of the Klickitat County Comprehensive Plan.

Discussion followed. Audience members Keith Arndt, Mike Smith, Jeff Eiesland, and Franklin Johnson all expressed opinions. Jack Kincheloe questioned as to which Comp Plan had been delivered to the Klickitat County Commissioners. Mike Smith said he had delivered the one that they used.

Mike Smith also read a portion of the SEPA resolution 19892. Jack Kincheloe explained that it did not apply to Klickitat County.

Portions of the Zoning Ordinance was read by Jack Kincheloe.

Keith Arndt argued against are appealing these proposals stating that we could be sorry and it could cost us in the long run. After Mr. Arndt spoke warning us that we could be sorry for filing appeals, Don McDermott asked the assembly what that sounded like to everyone. Several people spoke up at once saying "A Threat!" Mr. Arndt also stated that he objected to us using tax-payer monies to file the appeals. We told him that it was not tax payer money and that we sell ice cream every summer to fund our Community Council.

Jack made a motion to appeal both Sepa proposals. The filing fee would be \$175.00 each. The motion was seconded by Art Mengert. The council vote was unanimous.
